Cliff boy's last moments - court

A COURT yesterday heard grim evidence about the final moments of a young German footballer's life.

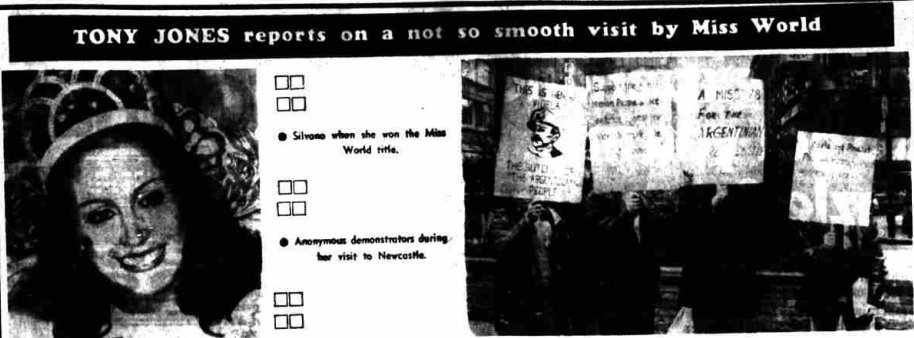
The 16-year-old probably lived for "some time" after plunging over a cliff, said a Home Office pathologist.

But he added, a number of the boy's wounds—incised before the fall which led to his death.

The jury, sitting for the third day of the murder trial at Newcastle Crown Court, also heard about bloodstains found on clothing belonging to the man who is the prosecution's chief witness—Thomas Meyer, of Dortmund, West Germany.

Speaking from behind Kenneth Clements' witness box and leaning forward, Meyer testified that he saw the boy's wounds.
