Summer 1978 - U2 form in Dublin - The Edge (guitars, piano and vocals), Bono (vocals, guitar), Larry Mullen (drums) and Adam Clayton (bass).  
December 1979 - first London shows. Club gigs such as the Hope and Anchor (where nine people turn up) and the Rock Garden.  
This period also sees the release of U23, a three track EP which gives U2 their first chart success in Eire. The record is
